Dear Bowlers and Friends,

We cordially invite you to **"Let the Good Times Roll in Chicago"** at the 68th Annual YMS of R / PNCC Bowling Tournament, **May 17-19, 2013**. The Tournament is the longest-running social event in the PNCC, and we are thrilled to finally bring it to the Windy City!

The Tournament is open to all PNCC Parishioners, members of PNU/Spojnia, and non-PNCC individuals belonging to a PNCC-sponsored bowling league. There are three bowling events (Singles, Doubles and Team) with prizes being awarded in four divisions (Open, Women's, Youth and Spojnia). The Singles and Doubles events are on Friday the 17th, and the Team event is on Saturday the 18th. You can bowl in all three events, or just one or two.

And Tournament Weekend is not just about the bowling! It's about making new friends, reuniting with old friends, and seeing the sights. Chicago has so much to see and do! We encourage you to bring your family and friends and stay an extra day or two. Enclosed are a Schedule of Events, Rules and Regulations, Registration Forms and other information you need to plan your Tournament weekend. 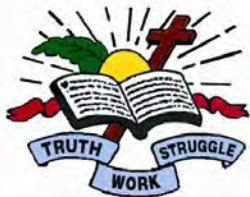

As you plan your driving, remember this...if there was a movie about getting around Chicago in a car,
it would be called "There Will Be Traffic". Give yourself plenty of time!

From Holiday Inn Express to Habetler Bowl

Turn **RIGHT** onto **Mannheim Road**. Travel **1.4 miles** and enter **I-190 EAST** to **Chicago Loop** on the **RIGHT (I-190 will turn into I-90 Kennedy Expressway)**. Travel **5.2 miles** and exit **Austin Avenue**. Turn **LEFT** onto **Avondale**, **RIGHT** onto **Austin**. Turn **LEFT** onto **Foster Avenue** (the first light) and travel **0.3 miles**. **Habetler Bowl** is on the **LEFT** just beyond the bridge/viaduct. There are two driveways on Foster, or you can turn **LEFT** on **Northwest Highway** to enter the lot.

From Habetler Bowl to All Saints

Turn **RIGHT** onto **Foster Avenue** (from the "short" end of the lot) and turn **RIGHT** to enter **I-90 West/Kennedy Expressway** just beyond the bridge/viaduct. Travel **3.2 miles** to exit **Cumberland Road North**. Turn **LEFT** onto **Higgins Road** and travel **1 mile** to **All Saints** on the **LEFT**, just beyond St. Nicholas Cemetery. There are two driveways.

From All Saints to Holiday Inn Express

Turn **LEFT** onto **Higgins Road**. Travel **1.7 miles** to **Mannheim Road** and turn **RIGHT**.
Holiday Inn Express is on your **LEFT**, and the driveway to enter is after the hotel sign.

From Holiday Inn Express to All Saints

Turn **RIGHT** onto **Mannheim Road** and immediately get into the **LEFT** turn lane. Turn **LEFT** onto **Higgins Road**. Travel **1.7 miles** to **All Saints** on your **RIGHT**, beyond North River Road, just past our Cemetery. There are two driveways.

(None of these trips requires payment of a toll.)

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE YMS of R / PNCC BOWLING TOURNAMENT

1. The Tournament is open to USBC certified and non-certified bowlers. All participants in the Tournament must be a member in good standing of one of the following:
 - the Polish National Catholic Church (PNCC)
 - the Polish National Union of America (PNU/Spójnia), or
 - a bowling league sponsored by members/organizations of the PNCC.
2. The Tournament has four divisions: Open, Women's, Youth, and Spójnia.
 - The Open Division is open to all participants.
 - The Women's Division is open to female participants only.
 - The Youth Division is open to male and female youth participants ages 13-17. Youth 13-17 years old may participate with the adult bowlers.
 - The Spójnia Division is restricted to members of the Polish National Union of America/Spójnia. Members are allowed to participate in this Division upon its approval.
3. HANDICAP – shall be 100% of the difference between the bowler's average and 200 for all Divisions, with no maximum.
4. AVERAGES – all bowlers in all Divisions of the Tournament must use one of the following for their average in the Tournament (in this order):
 - Highest average from the previous season, minimum 21 games.
 - Highest average from the current season as of January 1.
 - Tournament Average – a rolling four-year average of previous Tournament competition.
 - Highest average from the second previous season.
 - All others must bowl scratch with a 200 average.

USBC Rule 319a (the 10-pin rule) applies in this Tournament and must be used if the current season's highest average is 10 pins or more higher than last season's highest average.

Bowlers are responsible for the verification of their averages. Corrections may be made up to the end of the first game of the Tournament, unless a written request is made to the National Tournament Committee for an extension to 48 hours after the Tournament.

5. A Schedule of the Tournament Events will be sent to each captain.
6. Lane assignments will be drawn at random by the Host Tournament Committee and bowling center management (as applicable).
7. Awards and cash prizes will be paid based on total handicap scores. Any bowler can only cash once in each event and will be paid the highest prize earned.
8. Bowlers in the Youth division are not eligible for cash prizes and will receive alternate awards. In addition, USBC Youth members and their parents/guardians are expected to review USBC Rule 400 prior to competing.
9. Prize monies will be returned 100%. The number of prizes paid will be based upon entries received and will be based on USBC guidelines.

11. Entry fees must be in the form of a check or money order and made payable to **2013 Tournament Committee** and must accompany all entry forms. The deadline for submission of entries and payment is **April 15, 2013**.
12. The National Tournament Committee reserves all rights in rule interpretation, unusual circumstances, and enforcement and their decision shall be final.
13. USBC bylaws will apply in any situation not covered in these rules and regulations.
